- 1. A digital link of you performing two musical pieces. Original songs and pieces are encouraged and please include a verbal introduction before the performance.
- 2. A CV/resume with the following information included.

 - > Date of birth
 - > Country of origin
 - > Email address
 - > Contact telephone numbers both home and mobile
 - > Any studies or courses you have undertaken related to the music industry
 - > Any experiences or personal interests you have, that relate to the music industry
 - > A list of instrument (s) that you play
 - > Any computer skills or music software programs you have used
 - > Convenient times you are available to receive telephone calls if we need to contact you

After you submit your demonstration and CV/resume, you will be contacted to arrange a suitable time for an interview.
